JEWELLERY - SATURDAY 10 MAY

Learn to make your own jewellery in a one day workshop open to all levels

For beginners, there will be an introduction to jewellery tools and techniques with the making of a ring and stone set. For those with more experience, there will be an opportunity to learn new techniques such as casting, mixed media, enamelling and advanced stone setting.

TIME AND DATE: 10am to 4pm on Saturday 10 May (Lunch 12.30-1.30pm)

COURSE FEE: £45. This includes the cost of materials, including a ring and stone set (silver and cabachon). Other materials are available on request. All tools are supplied.

VENUE: THE STEEPLE, High Street, Newburgh, Fife.

COURSE TUTOR: **Gordon Stewart** DipArt. Gordon lives in Anstruther. He studied Art & Design and Stained Glass at Wrexham Art School, then went on to study jewellery at North College, Glasgow and Lauder College, Dunfermline. For the past eight years he has been teaching and delivering workshops and jewellery demonstrations, on both a vocational and non-vocational basis, throughout the Fife area. He currently teaches at Adam Smith College, Kirkcaldy.
